Member monthly volume by size (size-mix) can be modified on a monthly basis +/- 10% provided the total monthly case commitment remains the same.
What is the distribution channel (for everyday volume)?	Distribution or Direct from supplier
What is the product availability start date?	November 1, 2021 for monthly orders
What is the lead time for 90-day stockpile delivery?	90 days to build initial stockpile after credit approved and order is placed; 10 days for delivery once stockpile is built
Who holds the 90-day stockpile (held by supplier, direct only)?	Member's 90-day stockpile is calculated based on their monthly committed volume and is held by Supplier.
What is the 90-day supply warehousing fee(s)?	NONE

The Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program contracted suppliers provide additional inventory of essential products to mitigate supply disruptions and demand surge. Contract terms provide greater predictability and sustainability to drive continued production and supply resiliency. Production transparency requirements increase visibility to predict and further mitigate anticipated supply disruptions while shifting overseas manufacturing to the United States and/or North America when feasible. By purchasing through Novaplus Enhanced Supply, health care facilities also receive expanded value and benefits built on the foundation of the industry's longest-run private label program.

Members are not required to participate in the Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program to purchase other Novaplus products. If you are currently purchasing from contract, you may continue to purchase as usual without participating in the Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program.
Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program agreements are set up as separate contracts and have a separate enrollment process. Contract enrollment via Vizient Catalog is required for all purchases through Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program. To enroll in a contract Your enrollment status for each contract is displayed on the Facility Status line of the contract details page. If your facility is not enrolled in the contract, clicking the purple "Enroll Now" button will launch the tier activation process. If your facility is already enrolled in the contract, the button changes to read "Request a New Tier." If you qualify for a different tier from the one your facility is currently on, click this button to initiate a new tier request with the supplier. In either case, follow the prompts and provide all requested data until you reach the Submit stage. If the contract requires an enrollment form, the process will provide a facsimile of the form populated with your data, which you may view or print as needed. All enrollments and tier requests should be conducted via this process. Do not
send an email or fax/submit the form document in lieu of online activation. Immediate enrollment is not required. When members enroll, they can select a future effective date to begin to receive supply assurance.
No, members are not required to convert their full spend within a given product category.
Yes. Members can select which product types they would like to participate in without signing up for the full offering.
Access to your spend data allows us to accurately calculate your inventory needs based on your ordering and consumption patterns. It will also help us monitor inventory levels. Data submission is not required for participation.

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How is Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program compliance measured?	Members will work with the supplier to agree to an annual volume for the category and will be provided such inventory. Compliance will be measured against the agreed upon inventory.
How is my commitment volume calculated if I use the Vizient tools?	Organization specific historical ordering and invoicing patterns (both pre- and post-COVID-19) are evaluated in conjunction with seasonal flu and COVID-19 forecasting to identify future demand. Vizient's PPE Conservation Impact Calculator (https://www.vizientinc.com/my-dashboard/my-tools/calculator) will also be leveraged to help determine future PPE utilization. Used together, these are powerful predictors of your inventory need based on conditions in your facility and local area.
When do I have access to my 90-day stockpile?	Access dates will vary based on manufacturing ramp-up; see the individual contract brief for supply target dates.
How do I purchase my 90-day stockpile?	Provide notification to Supplier.
After I use my stockpile, will it be replenished?	Once a member calls in part or all of their 90-day stockpile inventory, the supplier will begin replenishing the inventory to the 90-day level.
How will inventory reporting be delivered to members?	Members will receive periodic inventory reporting from standard reports. Those members subscribed to Vizient's supply resilience solution will have near-real time inventory visibility through the solution.
Will this affect my compliance with the Impact Standardization Program?	If a member was already purchasing from the Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program supplier, they will continue to be measured against their established potential in the Impact Standardization Program. If a member is moving to the Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program supplier from a different supplier, they will need to switch their Impact Standardization Program supplier and establish a potential within the Impact Program with the Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program supplier.
Can Captis members participate in the Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program?	Captis members may participate in the Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program for any incremental amount beyond their current committed contract volumes
How do I terminate my participation in the Novaplus Enhanced Supply Program?	If you no longer wish to participate, you must provide 90 days' notice to the supplier, honor your purchase commitment for the notice period, and take delivery of the full 90 days of supply by the end of the notice period.
How do members gain access to the supply resilience solution?	Although not a requirement for participation, the supply resilience solution is a fee-for-service solution that improves trust, transparency and predictability across the supply chain. Are the Novaplus Nitrile Exam gloves tested for use with Chemotherapy drugs and Fentanyl Citrate?	Yes- all Novaplus Nitrile gloves are tested for use with chemotherapy drugs according to ASTM D6978 or ASTM F799-99a. For a complete list of the drugs tested contact Quality Assurance for a copy of test data. Caution: Gloves used for protection against chemotherapy drug exposure should be selected specifically for the type of chemical used. Review safety data sheets for the drug being used to determine the required level of protection.
